

Article 1: Applicability

The General Terms and Conditions Temporary Shower apply to the agreement to rent a temporary shower from Douche Service. This temporary shower includes a shower cabin, any pump and any hot water supply.

Article 2: Duration of the agreement

The rental agreement is entered into for a minimum of 2 weeks. In determining the duration of the agreement, a portion of a day is considered a full day. The duration is indicated by setting an end date of the rental. On the date of signing, the shower is installed.

Article 3: Installation of the shower cabin.

The shower cabin will be installed and connected by Douche Service and removed at the end of the rental agreement.

Article 4: Damages and defects.

The renter is obliged to immediately report any damage or defect during the rental period to Douche Service. Repair or other work on the rented property may only be carried out by Douche Service.

Article 5: Obligations of the renter

The user is obliged to use the rented property only in accordance with the purpose for which the rented property was made available. No changes may be made to the rented property and the shower cubicle may not be moved by the user on his own initiative after placement and installation by Douche Service, unless otherwise agreed to in contact by Douche Service. The user shall handle the rented property with care and caution.

Article 6: Use of temporary shower

The user shall provide a lockable tap to which the temporary facility of Douche Service can be connected. During the rental period of the temporary shower, the user is obliged to shut off the water supply immediately after showering. Douche Service provides, most commonly with the dishwasher or washing machine, a splitter with an additional shut-off valve between the water supply and the shower. For ease of use, the extra valve can be used to shut off the water. Douche Service is not liable for the damages/consequences caused by not providing a working shut-off supply valve, the consequences/damages of a supply valve not working properly or the consequences/damages of not complying with shutting off the water supply immediately after use.

Article 7: Risk and costs

From the moment that the shower cubicle is placed at the user's premises until the end of the agreement, when not adhered to article 4 or 5, all risk of the rented property is for the user. The costs of necessary repair of the rented property as a result of non-compliance with the obligations by user shall be borne by user. Costs caused by leakage of water from the temporary shower or any power outage shall be borne by user.

Article 8: Payment

The rental/connection costs as well as any costs that are to be borne by the tenant under the rental agreement must be paid before the date indicated on the invoice/contract. If the tenant does not pay on time, he is legally in default. If the lessee remains in default of paying the amount due even after a demand for payment, he is also obliged to pay collection costs. By collection costs is meant all costs made by Douche Service in and out of court for the collection of the amount due.

Article 9: Liability

The Douche Service is not liable for damage or loss as a result of fire, electric current, outflowing water or any cause whatsoever, which is the result of the non- or improper functioning of the rented property or any part thereof, if the preceding articles are not observed. This also applies to cables, wires and hoses.
